Rotary in Action: Backpacks, Home Team, and Sunflower Hill!

The Danville San Ramon Rotary Club had a busy and rewarding stretch of community service this summer.

On Friday, August 1, Rotarians completed the second phase of our backpack project for Shelter Inc. Members provided 31 boxes of essential school supplies, which were then sorted and assembled into backpacks for students from pre-K through high school. Thanks to everyone's efforts, 100 backpacks are now in the hands of local children who need them most.







The very next day, Saturday, August 2, our bi-monthly Rotary HOME Team was out helping seniors with minor home repairs and odd jobs. From spackling and yard work to moving heavy items, removing paint cans for recycling, and giving practical advice on small plumbing fixes, our volunteers visited four homes in total. We were also joined by three enthusiastic Cal High Interact students—future Rotarians in the making.



Earlier, on July 19, a team of Rotarians (and a few honorary helpers) assembled four convertible benches that transform into two picnic table sets for Sunflower Hill. Funded by a \$1,500 Community Service Grant from the DSR Rotary Foundation, these benches were installed on August 9 at Sunflower Hill's garden in Livermore. That day, 12 volunteers also pitched in with three hours of gardening to beautify the space.





All of these projects were made possible through the leadership and dedication of our Community Service Chair and longtime Rotarian, **Allen Mueller**—proof that with teamwork, compassion, and a little elbow grease, Rotary continues to make a difference.
